### FINDINGS



### RECOMMENDATIONS

- Recommendation number R8: **All law enforcement agencies should coordinate the enforcement of sales bans on flavored tobacco**, will not be implemented because it is not warranted.
  - Currently, all the jurisdictions of the Central Marin Police Authority (Larkspur, Corte Madera, and San Anselmo) have a ban on flavored tobacco, pursuant to their individual municipal codes. The code enforcement divisions of each town/city in coordination with the Central Marin Police Authority monitor and enforce the ban on sales of flavored tobacco. In addition, the Central Marin Police Authority requested and received a two-year grant to enforce tobacco laws in its jurisdiction and to assist other jurisdictions with their enforcement, should they desire. This program is currently being implemented. However, when the grant expires and should a renewal not be received, there is no justifiable need to coordinate or request assistance with law enforcement agencies outside of the Central Marin Police Authority to enforce the sales ban in Larkspur, Corte Madera, and San Anselmo.
